Scrip is selling like crazy. Have you bought your scrip yet? If you buy gas or groceries you could be using scrip. Scrip is a great way to help the school and your favorite student. A percentage of the profit goes into a student's tuition account of your choice to be used for next year. So start buying today!

Scrip is sold in the kitchen every morning that school is in session from 8-9:30. Scrip orders can be sent with your child in their folders and they will be returned the same way. Scrip is also sold at Zion and Christ Churches on Sundays.

Just a Reminder: A few people have had some problems with their scrip not working in the cash registers. The problem is cell phones. Scrip cards should be stored in a pocket separate from cell phones. Cell phones can demagnetize the strips on the back of the card.
