In the 8<sup>th</sup> century, All Saints' Day was proclaimed on November 1<sup>st</sup>, so October 31<sup>st</sup> became All Hallows' Eve. Reformation Day is celebrated on October 31<sup>st</sup> in Protestant churches. There is lots of history and tradition behind this day.
